- *Be willing to serve and represent the Office of Inclusion and Diversity and interface with the many communities which the University serves.*
- *Be an undergraduate or graduate student and must have been enrolled at Auburn University Main Campus for three semesters (excluding summer term), including the semester of selection.*
- *Be enrolled and be able to represent the Office of Inclusion and Diversity in a credible manner throughout the entire school year.*
- *Be able to attend scheduled mandatory training and agree to the time commitment to fulfill Ambassador duties.*

Responsibilities of Diversity Student Ambassadors **Diversity Student Ambassadors must:**

- *Attend all scheduled meetings.*
- *Assist at designated Office of Inclusion and Diversity sponsored events and receptions.*
- *Assist other student organizations, as appropriate.*
- *Be responsible to their advisor and the Office of Inclusion and Diversity.*

- *Serve as a "spokesperson" for the Office of Inclusion and Diversity*
- *Improvement and enhancement of interpersonal skills*
- *Development of leadership, group dynamics, communication, and public speaking skills*
